





# GETTING READY FOR YOUR LICENSE



Earning your Florida Class E driver license involves three key steps. We focus primarily on Step 3, but understanding the complete process is essential.

## Step 1: Driver Education Traffic Safety (DETS) Course

If you're a first-time driver, you must complete a state-approved Driver Education Traffic Safety course. This covers traffic laws, signs, and safety principles.



## Step 2: Knowledge Exam

Pass the written exam testing signs, signals, right-of-way, speed limits, and safe practices at a DMV office or center.

## STEP 3: THE CLASS E DRIVING SKILLS TEST


This is the road test—the focus of this course. You'll demonstrate your ability to safely operate a vehicle on public roads while an examiner evaluates your performance.







# VEHICLE REQUIREMENTS FOR THE TEST

## REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION:

Must be current and valid:



Current Registration



Florida Minimum Liability Insurance

**Note:** You must provide the vehicle. Renting? You must have the agreement.



# VEHICLE SAFETY REQUIREMENTS



Component	Requirement	Component	Requirement
Headlights	Both working (Hi/Lo)	Horn	Working
Taillights	Both working	Brakes	Functioning properly
Brake lights	Both working	Tires	Safe tread/inflation
Turn signals	All four working	Mirrors	Rearview & both sides
Windshield	No cracks obstructing vision	Doors	Open/Close properly
Seatbelts	Working (Front)	Speedometer	Working and visible

# VEHICLES NOT PERMITTED



Motorcycles (separate test required)



Vehicles with obstructed views



Vehicles requiring special licenses (commercial)



Rental vehicles without the rental agreement

**Pre-test inspection:** The examiner verifies documents and checks safety. If the vehicle fails, the test will be rescheduled.

# MANEUVERS: CORE AND INTERSECTION

## CORE DRIVING SKILLS



- Smooth acceleration from stops



- Controlled braking



- Proper steering technique



- Lane positioning and centering

## INTERSECTION MANEUVERS




- Right and Left turns



- Stopping at signs and red lights



- Proceeding through green lights



- Navigating four-way stops

# MANEUVERS: LANE CHANGES & PARKING


## SPECIFIC MANEUVERS




- ▶ Signalling & Blind spot checks



- ▶ Straight-line backing (~50 ft)



- ▶ Three-point turn (K-turn)




- ▶ Straight-in and/or Parallel parking

## OBSERVATION SKILLS



- ▶ Mirror and Shoulder checks



- ▶ Intersection scanning



- ▶ Awareness of pedestrians






